## OUR PROGRAMS & SERVICES

### EMERGENCY RELIEF

*Individuals and families facing unexpected crisis can attend for support. Support may vary but can include food or fuel vouchers.*

### COMMUNITY CONNECT

*Support, referral and advocacy for community to connect with services as required in times of need.*

### EARLY CONNECTIONS PROJECT

*Program to support parents from pregnancy to primary school, including events, activities, workshops and referrals.*

### COMMUNITY PANTRY

*Newly established initiative designed to support local families living below the poverty line with non-perishable necessities.*

### CENTRELINK AGENCY

*Access to Centrelink phones, computers and free wi-fi. Staff on hand to help visitors use computers.*

### COMMUNITY GROUNDS – SOCIAL ENTERPRISE CAFÉ

*Hospitality training and employment support for young people in operational country café. Includes community library, gallery & services info hub.*

### BE CONNECTED (COMPUTER TRAINING)

*Individualised training for Seniors on computer use – by appointment.*

### YOUTH ACTIVITIES

*Youth engagement activities including school holiday programs to support positive outcomes (dates/times vary depending on funding).*

### DRESS FOR SUCCESS

*Support for young people (under 21 years) accessing employment including uniforms, haircuts, tools & resume support.*

### CRAFTS AND LAUGHS

*Connect socially with others while making goods to donate to those in need or BYO project - Every Friday – 9:30 – 12pm.*

### FREE COMPUTERS & WI-FI

*Computers to access for job & rentals search, emails and social connectivity incl. free Wi-Fi.*
